


# Welcome to the 8<sup>th</sup> edition of our monthly newsletter, keeping you up to date on the developments on the Lakes Estate Renewal Project.





Windermere Drive A1	11A Masonry commenced and ongoing to internal and external walls. 11B first floor slab cured	Masonry ongoing to ground floor area of 11A. 11B masonry and wind post works to progress
Windermere Drive A3	Block 8A roof works complete and scaffold stripped. Block 8B roof works ongoing	8A commence internals. 8B complete roof works, scaffold strip and commence internals
Melfort Drive	Block 1 roof works and windows complete. Blocks 1B and 1C mansards ongoing. Blocks 2A, 3A, 3B, 3C, 4A, 4C and 4C masonry ongoing. Block 5 floor planks installed	1B and 1C mansard completion. Ongoing masonry to rest of blocks. Block 1A commence internals
Burnmoor Close	Block 1 structure complete and first floor planks installed. Block 2 window and roof truss complete. Roof tiles ongoing	Brickwork to complete and mansard commencement on block 1. Block 2 complete roof tiles and remove scaffold
Drayton Road	External drainage and services progressing. Masonry and roof trusses on south side continuing. New foundations to apartment blocks complete. Precast plank installs commenced	Attenuation tanks complete 1A-2A. Continuation of precast planks, masonry and roof work. Substation base install
